Step 3: type in password (default is father's work number without area code. If it does not work, please use mother's work number without area code. If it still does not work, please use your mobile phone number without area code. If it still does not work, please contact registration --ghuang@bu.edu)

Step 4: Check one item from student affairs table.

Step 5: Check one item from academic affairs/PTA table.

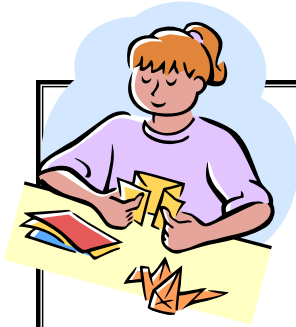
Step 6: click on submit button at the bottom of the page.

RCLS 2008 青少年夏令營回顧



七月熱鬧登場 歡樂中國節慶氣氛 豐碩學習 分享快樂時光

RCLS 今年暑假在洛麗華人基督教會舉辦夏令營，共有 92 位校內、外學員參加，接受一週純正、鄉土的有趣課程，學員和家長們也都同時經歷了一次難得中國文化洗禮。

這次經由台灣僑務委員會贊助、亞特蘭大華僑文教中心協辦的夏令營活動，最大的特色是擁有豐富的師資及龐大的社區資源。共有三位遠從台灣來的指導老師：廖文榮、朱黛南、陳傳宗為學員們教授民俗藝術、民俗舞蹈和民俗體育。活動安排得既緊湊又有趣，舉凡童玩、中國水墨畫、捏麵人、折紙、皮影戲、結繩、剪紙、戲偶制作與操演等，都令學員們大開眼界，趣味無窮。負責民俗舞蹈的朱黛南老師還針對不同年齡的學員設計了四套舞曲，包括：山地舞、功夫舞蹈，和加入鼓和八角巾表演的歡喜鑼鼓。還有最受學員們歡迎又可活動筋骨的民俗體育。指導老師陳傳宗特別從台灣帶來各式的陀螺，教授學員們踢花式毬子、花式跳繩，及變化多端的高級扯鈴動作。樣樣技藝，都讓這些在美國長大的青少年們嘆為觀止。

同時，本地的優良師資更充實了整個活動的質與量。包括有：劉瑪玲的中國水墨畫、陳淑美的中國結、陳雯儀的美勞、高永生的太極拳、李克良的中國功夫、盧沂的民族舞蹈、蘇美蘭的穴道按摩等等…都受到極大的歡迎。尤其，難能可貴的是前校長郭震威，特別為不具中文學習基礎的學員，開設中文教學班，讓不同中文背景的學員，也能淺嘗學習中國文化的樂趣。經過一周緊湊的學習，學員們在最後一天的成果展上，果然表現得可圈可點。學員、家長們、指導老師，以及營區工作人員們，同享了一回別出生面的中國節慶嘉年華會。有些原本被迫參加的學員，竟然歡喜地表達出下回再來的心聲，讓這次耗費全心全力的主辦與協辦單位，感到無限的欣慰與鼓勵。旦願 RCLS 能夠有機會繼續主辦如此快樂的夏令營。
